1. Call to Order/Roll Call: James called the meeting to order and roll call was taken. Also present for the meeting was Supervisors Wesley Ginter and Tom Vollmar, & Clerk/Treasurer Sandy Frank. Others totaled 3.
2. Motion by the board to approve the stated allowable levy, including the allowable levy increase for the 2017 tax collected in 2018 in the amount of \$256,832.00. (2/3 board vote needed to pass) Motion by James Anderson, Second by Wesley Ginter to Approve the allowable 2017 levy collected in 2018. All in favor, motion carried.
3. Motion to Adopt the resolution by the town meeting endorsing a town board resolution which proposed that the town exceed the state allowable levy limit due to increases in public safety contracts of \$12,000.00.: Motion made by Cora Campbell to approve the resolution adopted by the board proposing the town exceeds the state allowable levy limit due to increases in safety contracts by \$12,000.00. Second by Seifred Schnappup, 7 ayes 0 opposed.
4. Motion by electors to Adopt 2017 Town Tax Levy Payable in 2018 in the amount of \$268,832.00: Motion by Cora Campbell to adopt the 2017 Town Tax Levy payable in 2018. Second by Siegfried Schnappup. 7 Aye, 0 opposed. Motion carried.
5. Adjourn: Cora made a motion to adjourn, second by Kim Schnapupp. All in favor, motion carried.
